Dear Colleagues

May we start by thanking all of you for your excellent work with recruitment to STRIDER UK so far. We have soared past our half way target during the summer break with 69 women now recruited to the study, well towards our target of 112.

Unfortunately with this success we have had to take some difficult decisions and we would like to remind all participating sites that we really do need the Angiogenic blood samples for all women participating in the study as it is a core outcome for our EME funding.

You will have all received or be receiving a list of data discrepancies from data entered on the eCRF platform REDCAP.

This list represents missing or queried data which we would be very keen to capture , an area where we have most missing data is with the Fetal assessments, please can we remind you all to ensure all fetal assessments listed on the CRF are taken.

Please take the time to look carefully through these lists and complete as much data as possible to ensure that we have the most information available from women participating in the STRIDER study to inform us of the effect of sildenafil on IUGR.

Finally we would like to remind you all that SAE forms should be completed by the PI at each site and reported to the LCTU within 24hrs of them becoming aware of a potential SAE.

The most common SAEs to be encountered are stillbirths and neonatal deaths.
